# 8. Archives

# **Phil** reported:

Three more Classic Cars For Sale handed to **lan** - they still send them after only 1 advert - they have asked us to ad again but I feel "Classic" is inappropriate.

The 6 window panes have been UV filmed on advice from Faye the Aston-Martin Archivist who visited us at the start - lowest of 2 local competitive quotes was £168.03.

A new main door Lock has been bought and fitted - cost about £90,

The auctioneer /valuer has advised us to re-foliate the Stanley Edge drawings as they were done over 35 years ago by the Somerset County Archivist and have now gone past their sell-by date. Leicestershire County Archivist to be approached to do them as they did the twin-cam engine drawing for PWA7C - expected to be about £1000.

Bought on e-bay: a 1926 Parts List for £26.99 - the old photocopy one is now free if wanted.

Bought on e-bay a 1922 - yes a 1922 FIRST EDITION parts list for £176. The dealer from Inverness had picked it up at a SCA7C Auto-jumble at Doune with other A7 books - he had absolutely no idea of its rarity until bidding went crazy! It shows all the first production parts available from the November 1922 Motor Show - resumé for the Mag. promised.

Bought, via Jim Stringer of VAR, 10 old A7 cuttings for £9, including a super mention of a purple and black Swallow ordered by a Far Eastern HH the Sultan of Perak - Perak is middle left on the Malay peninsula - roughly equivalent to King of Malaysia! – watch out in the Mag.

Open Day last December was attended with respective companions by Robin Taylor Big 7 Registrar, Chris Garner PWA7C Archivist, Dave Morgan - even stray TSSC men came up to see who the silver lady is!

PWA7C have already rented the whole of Room 1 and will soon be filling up the cabinets. BA7C have deposited 2 boxes of their Club films - other Clubs may wish to see what we have and then place things with us - current rent is £13.50 per sq ft. including A7CA contents insurance.

I intend to do three more colour reprints for 2012, hopefully Vans/Ulster/Another - covering other models than we did 2-3 years ago.

Our three regular selling posters will continue but oiling charts have now sold out - we may look at these again if there's sufficient demand.

MEETING agreed £1000 for re-sealing the irreplaceable original Stanley Edge drawings.

MEETING suggested an Association Budget of £3000 for the forthcoming Financial Year in respect of future Archive acquisitions.

**Meeting** were firmly of the view that all manufacturing errors should be brought to the attention of the provider and, only if un-responsive, report the matter to the Association who could provide an advisory 'health-warning; to members.

# 9.2 Breakdown Register

**Gordon** reported that recent responses ad markedly improved and the number of 'gaps' were very few. To cover these omissions, it was agreed to replicate the Club Contact List from the Mag at the end of the Register. It was also agreed that a note would be included in the Register to underline the need to keep one's car in good order together with a list of 'suggested spares' to carry in the vehicle. It is planned to publish the Register very shortly.

# Attachment 4c. <u>Invoices for Magazines, Postal Charges and Subscriptions</u> - System Changes from January 2011

A7CA has been looking at the current system for charging the costs of magazines and postage to Clubs and have concluded that the existing system needs simplifying and updating.

The following system applies from January 2011:

#### **Magazines:**

There will be no changes at all to the system for distribution of magazines, Clubs able to do so are
welcome to collect Magazines from Gaydon when the Association holds its quarterly meetings - where
this happens there will be no postage charges.

[NOTE: Les will be there from 10.30am in the rear Car Park until just before 11am to distribute prior to the Meeting]

- 2. UK Clubs will in future receive only one Invoice for each year's magazines, not four as currently operates.
- 3. An Invoice will be sent for Magazines following the distribution of the second magazine in each year, so for next year an Invoice will be sent following the issue of 2011B, covering Magazine costs (including Back Numbers to date) and postage.
- 4. This Invoice will, for 2011, include the actual numbers for 2011A and 2011B plus an estimate for 2011C and 2011D based on the actual numbers for 2011A and 2011B so if a Club had, say 50 copies of 2011A and 60 copies of 2011B, the total charged for 2011 would be for 230 copies (2011A + 2011B + 2 issues estimated based on 2011B).
- 5. When you want to change your number of Magazines, do notify Les Gammon in the usual way.
- 6. If there turns out to be difference between the actual number sent and the number charged, the difference will be adjusted (up or down) in the invoice for 2012 and so on.
- 7. Overseas clubs will be invoiced for all Magazine costs at the end of the year, as currently.
- 8. The cost of the Association Magazine remains at £1 per copy (including Back Numbers).

#### Attachment 4c. - cont.

#### **Postal Charges:**

- 1. At the Association meeting 17 January 2010, it was agreed that postage costs of Magazines would be paid for by Clubs and Registers .
- 2. From January 2011, Clubs/Registers will pay postage costs and these will be included in an Annual Magazine Invoice.
- 3. For 2011 the Annual Invoice will include postage for 2011A and 2011B. In 2012, the Invoice will include postage for 2011C and 2011D plus 2012A and 2012B and so on in the future.
- 4. Overseas clubs will be invoiced with the actual cost for the year as their Invoice will be sent after 2011D as now.

NOTE: Postal Charges will not apply if Clubs/Registers collect Magazines.

#### In Conclusion:

It is hoped that this system will produce a number of benefits both for members and myself:

- Clubs will only have to deal with <u>one payment each year</u> not four so it will save your Treasurer some work.
- Invoicing will take place mid-year so overall the cash-flow effect is neutral for Clubs and the Association.
- My work load as Association Treasurer will be reduced.
- The system of chasing outstanding debts will be easier to administer.

NOTE: In future invoices will be sent, wherever possible, to the member club's email contact held by A7CA
